OHP III is a light installation that investigates the poetic potential of an obsolete technological medium, the overhead projector. The additional film rolls of the projector, usually manually operated, are moved and controlled through motors and sensors. Those augmentations control the behaviour of 20-meters-long hand-drawn transparent film foils, which roll and unroll back and forth with different speed and rhythm. The overhead projector thereby becomes an alternative filmic device. Analogue images, patterns or texts are mechanically moved and slowly mutate creating a choreography.
